

SITE SUPPORT
(Volunteer position only)

Requirements of Position:

- Willing to share in the support of the site and facility staff teams to assist with our camping program.
- Willing to participate in all training programs required for this position. These training dates will be provided with the offer of volunteering.
- Provide all required documentation within the set timeframes identified in volunteer agreement.

Qualifications:

- Current throughout period of volunteering:
 - Criminal Records Check to comply with the requirement of obtaining the equivalent of membership in Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada.
- Knowledge of the Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada program is an asset.

Reports to: Camp Director

Responsibilities:

Section One: General

- Be an effective role model to campers and colleagues. This includes but is not limited to living the vision, mission and values of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada, the respectful treatment of all campers/staff, compliance with all rules/regulations, maintaining a clean & safe work/living environment and general behaviour.
- Actively participate in the resolution of concerns that may arise within the team or with campers and implement appropriate process for the management of such.
- Notify the Camp Director of any concerns as they arise.

Section Two: Site Support

- Train and understand the safety concerns and equipment/products that are being used.
- Wear appropriate clothing and use appropriate equipment for the tasks assigned.
- Assist in the manner that they may require assistance such as (but not limited to): washroom cleaning, dish washing (pots and pans), laundry (bedwetters), kitchen cleaning, pitching/striking tents, tent repairs, and/or gardening (tasks will vary to site to site, week by week).

People taking on this position, should be in good physical shape so that the tasks can be performed and so that the person can walk to the location where the task has to be performed. We don't plan on the work in this role to be physically grueling however there is a physical component to the role. People taking on this position must be able to work well independently.

Notes:

- THIS POSITION IS AVAILABLE EACH AND EVERY DAY THAT THE SUMMER CAMP IS IN OPERATION INCLUDING OVER WEEKENDS, BEFORE CAMPERS ARRIVE AND AFTER THEY HAVE DEPARTED.
- This role doesn't have a defined period. You can come for a day, a week, or a month+.
- Individuals staying overnight will stay in a tent and will have to bring their own cot or air mattress. Occasionally, we may have an indoor space available but we cannot guarantee this.
- Volunteers in this role may be able to bring their own trailer depending on the site. Please contact our camp office to verify.
- It is the responsibility of the individual to obtain and retain current certification prior to the start of their volunteering. The cost of certification is that of the individual.
