# TERMS OF REFERENCE

#### (To be used in conjunction with the Committees' Generic Terms of Reference)

### PURPOSE

To stimulate an interest in International activities at all levels of Guiding and promote the sisterhood of Guiding.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

In addition to the Generic Terms of Reference, the Provincial International Committee shall:

- 1. Organize international events and activities for girls and/or Guiders with the approval of, or at the request of, BC Council.
- 2. Promote the Canadian World Friendship Fund.
- 3. Promote awareness of WAGGGS, WAGGGS initiatives and global issues.
- 4. Maintain the BC Council collection of WAGGGS flags.
- 5. Promote and support international group trips: nationally-sponsored, provincially-sponsored, and independent.
- 6. Promote and support nationally-sponsored domestic trips.
- 7. Support independent group trip planning and approve trips for travel outside of Canada to WAGGGS countries.
- 8. Ensure that girls and Guiders selected for nationally-sponsored and provinciallysponsored trips, and approved independent group trip participants, are prepared for travel.
- 9. Promote and support nationally-approved and provincially-approved international projects.
- 10. Promote and support the inclusion of international content in program delivery.
