Europe

Activity #1: High Tea and Fascinators

Asia

Activity #1: Learn about an Invention

Many inventions we use every day, such as paper and the compass, were created in Asia. Do some research to learn about an invention from this continent. Learn as much as you can about your invention and share it with your unit. Try to get creative in how you share. As an extra challenge, choose an invention that you have used during the past couple of days.

Activity #2: Learn a Recipe

The continent of Asia comprises over 40 countries. Many of these countries have their own cuisine. Choose a country and learn about their traditional foods. Then, either cook or buy food that you can try as a group. During this process, try to learn about the food's origins.

You can use the following prompts to do so:
Does the food come from a particular region?
Is it made during a special festival or ceremony?
Is there any interesting history about the food you chose?

Oceania

Activity #1: Animal Charades

Act out these types of animals found in Oceania without talking. Use hand gestures, body movements, pantomiming, etc for the audience to guess! Once you have gone through the list, ask your unit to try and think of any other animals they might know of that live in this continent.

South America

Activity #1: Recycled Art

Countries of South America such as Brazil are home to many different types or trees, which as we know, are transformed to make many items we use daily. It is extremely important that we protect these forests as well as the biodiversity in these countries. For this activity, research/brainstorm some craft/invention ideas that you can make using recycled materials. As you brainstorm, think about why it is important to recycle. Once you have your ideas, bring one to life by building/creating it.

Activity #2: Artist Inspiration

South America is home to some of the richest biodiversity in the world. Many of the species are at risk of extinction because the land they live on is being transformed into living areas or cut down to make different products. If you were to come up with an eco-friendly product, what would you design? What impact would this have on the planet? What current problem would it solve? Do not worry about the logistics of production, whatever idea comes to mind is valid!
